RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PFLUGERVILLE, TEXAS, ACKNOWLEDGING THE PETITION AND SUBSEQUENT RELEASE OF APPROXIMATELY 19.861 ACRES LOCATED GENERALLY NORTHEAST OF THE WOLF PACK DRIVE AND WEISS LANE INTERSECTION FROM THE EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE CITY OF PFLUGERVILLE BY OPERATION OF LAW IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 42.105(d) OF THE TEXAS LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE.

WHEREAS, the Texas State 88th Legislature approved Senate Bill 2038 which allows for the release of an area by petition of landowner or resident from an extraterritorial jurisdiction per Chapter 42, Subchapter D; and

WHEREAS, the City received a petition for release from the City of Pflugerville's extraterritorial jurisdiction from Elizabeth Ann Tyner, Independent Executor of the Estate of Irby Max Ford, deceased, for approximately 19.861 acres located generally northeast of the Wolf Pack Drive and Weiss Lane intersection; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Development Services Department has verified the signatures and petition to be in accordance with Sections 42.101-105 of the Texas Local Government Code; and

WHEREAS, the area described in the petition provided herein as Exhibit "A" will be considered released by operation of law in accordance with Section 42.105(d).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PFLUGERVILLE:

That City Council hereby acknowledges the petition and subsequent release of approximately 19.861 acres located generally northeast of the Wolf Pack Drive and Weiss Lane intersection as described in Exhibit "A" from the City of Pflugerville's extraterritorial jurisdiction by operation of law in accordance with Section 42.105(d) of the Texas Local Government Code.
