Mr. Wade:

As your partner in providing solid waste services to the City of Pflugerville, Progressive Waste Solutions always strives to provide this quality service at the lowest possible price.

We respectfully convey a request for a rate adjustment in accordance with the Terms of the Agreement in 2010 and as amended in 2012. Excerpts of those documents are attached for your reference. There has been no adjustment in the rates since prior to 2012. Meanwhile, we have been incurring increases in the costs of labor, maintenance, insurance and disposal.

The criteria we are basing our request is the percent change in the Consumer Price Index from November 2012 and November 2013 to November 2015. The CPI-U percentage for the time frame of November 2012 to November 2015 is 3.0% and is based upon the Consumer Price Index for all Urban Consumers (All Items). 2012 is the time frame that a previous rate adjustment request would have been eligible but, due to the amendment, was waived until 2016. As a comparison the CPI-U percentage for the time frame of November 2013 to November 2015 is 2%. The CPI data from the U.S. Bureau of Labor is attached for your reference.

The calculations are as follows:

CPI November 2012 = 230.221 CPI November 2015 = 237.336

237.336 - 230.221 = 7.115

7.115 divided by 230.221 = 0.0309 = 3.1 = 3% change

As a comparison, using data comparing November 2013 to 2015:

CPI November 2013 = 233.069 CPI November 2015 = 237.336

237.336 - 233.069 = 4.3

4.3 divided by 233.069 = 1.8 = 2.0% change

The CPI adjustment will equal a total adjustment to rates of all residential accounts. We are requesting that the rate increase will be scheduled to take effect on February 1, 2016.
