# **AGREEMENT**

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the premises and of the mutual covenants and agreements of the parties hereto to be by them respectively kept and performed as hereinafter set forth, it is agreed as follows:

# 1. DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION

The City	will prepare or provide for the construction plans for the facility, and will provide
for the construc	ction work as required by said plans at no cost to the State. Said plans shall include the
design of the	access control, necessary horizontal and vertical clearances for highway structures
adequate lands	cape treatment, adequate detail to ensure compliance with applicable structural design
standards, suffi	cient traffic control provisions, and general layout. They shall also delineate and define
the construction	n responsibilities of both parties hereto. Completed plans will be submitted to State for
review and app	proval and when approved shall be attached to the agreement and made a part thereof
in all respects.	Construction shall not commence until plans have been approved by the State. Any
future revisions	or additions shall be made after prior written approval of the State. Any sidewalks
curb ramps ar City	nd other pedestrian elements to be constructed, either on site or off site, by the shall be in accordance with the requirements of Title II of the Americans With
Disabilities Act	(ADA) and with the Texas Accessibility Standards (TAS). Elements constructed by the
City	and found not to comply with ADA or TAS shall be corrected at the entire expense
of the	City

# 2. INSPECTION

Ingress and egress shall be allowed at all times to such facility for Federal Highway Administration personnel and State Forces and equipment when highway maintenance operations are necessary, and for inspection purposes; and upon request, all parking or other activities for periods required for such operations will be prohibited.

# 3. PARKING REGULATIONS

Parking regulations shall be established limiting parking to single unit motor vehicles of size and capacity no greater than prescribed for  $1^{1}/_{2}$  ton trucks, such vehicles to conform in size and use to governing laws. Parking shall be permitted only in marked spaces.

Parking shall be prohibited when a security threat, as determined by TxDOT, exists.

# 4. PROHIBITION/SIGNS

Regulations shall be established prohibiting the parking of vehicles transporting flammable or explosive loads and prohibiting use of the area in any manner for peddling, advertising or other purposes not in keeping with the objective of a public facility. The erection of signs other than those required for proper use of the area will be prohibited. All signs shall be approved by the State prior to the actual erection.

# 5. RESPONSIBILITIES

Maintenance and operation	on of the facility shall be entirely the responsibility of the
City	. Such responsibility shall not be transferred, assigned or conveyed to
a third party without the	advanced written approval of the State. Further, such responsibility shall
include picking up trash,	mowing and otherwise keeping the facility in a clean and sanitary condition,
and surveillance by police	ce patrol to eliminate the possible creation of a nuisance or hazard to the
public. Hazardous or	unreasonably objectionable smoke, fumes, vapor or odors shall not be
permitted to rise above	the grade line of the highway, nor shall the facility subject the highway to
hazardous or unreasonal	bly objectionable dripping, droppings or discharge of any kind, including rain
or snow.	

# 6. FEES

Any fees levied for use of the facilities in the area shall be nominal and no more than are sufficient to defray the cost of construction, maintenance and operations thereof, and shall be subject to State approval.

# 7. TERMINATION UPON NOTICE

This provision is expressly made subject to the rights herein granted to both parties to terminate this agreement upon notice, and upon the exercise of any such right by either party, all obligations herein to make improvements to said facility shall immediately cease and terminate.

# 8. MODIFICATION/TERMINATION OF AGREEMENT

If in the sole judgment of the State it is found at any future time that traffic conditions have so changed that the existence or use of the facility is impeding maintenance, damaging the highway facility, impairing safety or that the facility is not being properly operated, that it constitutes a nuisance, is abandoned, or if for any other reason it is the State's judgment that such facility is not in the public interest, this agreement under which the facility was constructed may be: (1) modified if corrective measures acceptable to both parties can be applied to eliminate the objectionable features of the facility; or (2) terminated and the use of the area as proposed herein discontinued.

# 9. PROHIBITION OF STORAGE OF FLAMMABLE MATERIALS

All structures located or constructed within the area covered by the agreement shall be fire resistant. The storage of flammable, explosive or hazardous materials is prohibited. Operations deemed to be a potential fire hazard shall be subject to regulation by the State.

# 10. RESTORATION OF AREA

The _	City	shall provide written	notification to the Sta	te that such facility will be
discon	tinued for the purpose of	defined herein. The	City	shall, within thirty (30) days
from t	ne date of said notifica	tion, clear the area of	all facilities that were	its construction responsibility
under	this agreement and res	store the area to a cor	dition satisfactory to t	he State.

# 11. PREVIOUS AGREEMENTS

It is understood that this agreement in no way modifies or supersedes the terms and provisions of any existing agreements between the parties hereto.

# 12. INDEMNIFICATION

Each party acknowledges that it is not an agent, servant, or employee of the other party. Each party is responsible for its own acts and deeds and for those of its agents, servants, or employees.

Neither party hereto intends to waive, relinquish, limit or condition its right to avoid any such liability by claiming its governmental immunity.

When notified by the State to do so, the other party hereto shall within thirty (30) days from receipt of the State's written notification pay the State for the full cost of repairing any damages to the highway facility which may result from its construction, maintenance or operation of the facility, and shall promptly reimburse the State for costs of construction and/or repair work made necessary by reason of such damages.

# 15. USE OF RIGHT OF WAY

It is understood that the State by execution of this agreement does not impair or relinquish the State's right to use such land for highway purposes when it is required for the construction or re-construction of the traffic facility for which it was acquired, nor shall use of the land under such agreement ever be construed as abandonment by the State of such land acquired for highway purposes, and the State does not purport to grant any interest in the land described herein but merely consents to such use to the extent its authority and title permits.

# 16. ADDITIONAL CONSENT REQUIRED

The State asserts only that it has sufficient title for highway purposes. The \_\_\_\_\_\_City shall be responsible for obtaining such additional consent, permits or agreement as may be necessary due to this agreement. This includes, but is not limited to, appropriate permits and clearances for environmental, ADA and public utilities.

# 17. FHWA ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

If the Facility is located on the Federal-Aid Highway System, "ATTACHMENT A", which states additional requirements as set forth in the Federal Highway Administration's Title 23, Code of Federal Regulations, § 710, shall be attached to and become a part of this agreement.

# 18. CIVIL RIGHTS ASSURANCES

The \_\_\_\_\_\_\_, for itself, its personal representatives, successors and interests and assigns, as part of the consideration hereof, does hereby covenant and agree as a covenant running with the land that: (1) no persons, on the grounds of race, color, sex, age, national origin, religion or disabling condition, shall be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination in the use of said facility; (2) that in the construction of any improvements on, over or under such land and the furnishing of services thereon, no person on the ground of race, color, sex, age, national origin, religion or disabling condition, shall be excluded from participation in, denied the benefits of, or otherwise be subjected to discrimination; (3) that the

City \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ shall use the premises in compliance with all other requirements imposed by or pursuant to Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Department of Transportation, Subtitle A, Office of the Secretary, Part 21, Non-discrimination in Federally-Assisted programs of the Department of Transportation - Effectuation of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, and as said Regulations may be amended.

That if in the event of any breach of the above non-discrimination covenants, the State shall have the right to terminate the agreement and reenter and repossess said land and the facilities thereon, and hold the same as if said agreement had never been made or issued.

# 19. AMENDMENTS

Any changes in the time frame, character or responsibilities of the parties hereto shall be enacted by a written amendment executed by both parties hereto.

# 20. LEGAL CONSTRUCTION

In case one or more of the provisions contained in this agreement shall for any reason be held invalid, illegal or unenforceable in any respect, such invalidity, illegality or unenforceability shall not affect any provision hereof and this agreement shall be construed as if such invalid, illegal, or unenforceable provision had never been contained in this agreement.

# **21. AUDIT**

# 22. AUTHORITY OF STATE AUDITOR

The state auditor may conduct an audit or investigation of any entity receiving funds from the state directly under the contract or indirectly through a subcontract under the contract. Acceptance of funds directly under the contract or indirectly through a subcontract under this contract acts as acceptance of the authority of the state auditor, under the direction of the legislative audit committee, to conduct an audit or investigation in connection with those funds. An entity that is the subject of an audit or investigation must provide the state auditor with access to any information the state auditor considers relevant to the investigation or audit.

# 23. COMPLIANCE OF THE LAW

The \_\_\_\_\_ shall comply with all federal, state, and local law, statutes, ordinances, rules and regulations and with the orders and decrees of any courts or administrative bodies or tribunals in any manner affecting the performance of this agreement.


Inasmuch as this project is on the Federal-Aid highway system, the following additional requirements as applicable with the Federal Highway Administration's Title 23, Code of Federal Regulations, § 710.

- 1. Any significant revision in the design or construction of the facility shall receive prior approval by the Texas Department of Transportation subject to concurrency by the FHWA.
- 2. Any change in the authorized use of airspace shall receive prior approval by the Texas Department of Transportation subject to concurrence by the FHWA.
- 3. The airspace shall not be transferred, assigned or conveyed to another party without prior Texas Department of Transportation approval subject to concurrence by the FHWA.
- 4. This agreement will be revocable in the event that the airspace facility ceases to be used or is abandoned.




COMBINATION CURB RAMPS








(Sidewalk adjacent to curb) DIRECTIONAL RAMPS WITHIN RADIUS


## General Notes

### Curb Romos


- 1. Install a curb romp or blended transition at each pedestrian street crossing.
- All slopes shown are maximum allowable. Lesser slopes that will still drain properly should be used. Adjust curb ramp length or grade of approach sidewalks as directed.
- 3. The minimum sidewalk width is 5'. Where the sidewalk is adjacent to the back of curb, o 6' sidewalk width is desirable. Where o 5' sidewalk cannot be provided due to site constraints, sidewalk width may be reduced to 4' for short distances. 5'x 5' passing areas at intervals not to exceed 200' are required.
- 4. Landings shall be 5'x 5' minimum with a maximum 2% slope in any direction.
- Maneuvering space at the bottom of curb ramps shall be a minimum of 4'x 4' wholly
  contained within the crosswalk and wholly outside the parallel vehicular travel path.
- 6. Maximum allowable cross slope on sidewalk and curb ramp surfaces is 2%.
- Provide flored sides where the pedestrian circulation path crosses the curb ramp. Flored sides shall be sloped at 10% maximum, measured parallel to the curb. Returned curbs may be used only where pedestrians would not normally wolk across the ramp, either because the adjacent surface is planted, substantially obstructed, or otherwise protected.
- Additional information on curb ramp location, design, light reflective value and texture may be found in the current edition of the Texas Accessibility Standards (TAS) and 16 TAC 68.102.
- To serve as a pedestrian refuge area, the median should be a minimum of 6' wide, measured from bock of curbs. Medians should be designed to provide accessible passage over or through them.
- Small channelization islands, which do not provide a minimum 5'x 5' landing at the top
  of curb ramps, shall be cut through level with the surface of the street.
- 11. Crosswalk dimensions, crosswalk markings and stop bar locations shall be as shown elsewhere in the plans. At intersections where crosswalk markings are not required, curb ramps shall align with theoretical crosswalks unless otherwise directed.
- Handrails are not required on curb ramps. Provide curb ramps wherever on accessible route crosses (penetrates) a curb.
- Curb ramps and landings shall be constructed and paid for in accordance with Item 53
   —"Sidewalks".
- Place concrete at a minimum depth of 5" for ramps, flares and landings, unless otherwise directed.
- 15. Provide a smooth transition where the curb ramps connect to the street.
- 16. Curbs shown on sheet 1 within the limits of payment are considered part of the curb ramp for payment, whether it is concrete curb, gutter, or combined curb and gutter.
- Existing features that comply with TAS may remain in place unless otherwise shown on the plans.

# Detectable Warning Material


- 18. Curb ramps must contain a detectable warning surface that consists of raised truncated dames complying with Section 705 of the TAS. The surface must contrast visually with adjoining surfaces, including side flares. Furnish and install an approved cost-in-place dark brown or dark red detectable warning surface material adjocent to uncolored concrete, unless specified elsewhere in the plans.
- Detectable Warning Materials must meet TxDOT Departmental Materials Specification DMS 4350 and be listed on the Material Producer List. Install products in accordance with manufacturer's specifications.
- 20. Detectable warning surfaces must be slip resistant and not allow water to occumulate.
- Detectable warning surfaces shall be a minimum of 24" in depth in the direction of
  pedestrian travel, and extend the full width of the curb ramp or landing where the
  pedestrian access route enters the street.
- 22. Detectable warning surfaces shall be located so that the edge nearest the curb line is at the back of curb. Align the rows of domes to be perpendicular to the grade break between the ramp run and the street. Detectable warning surfaces may be curved along the corner radius.
- 23. Shoded areas on Sheet 1 of 4 indicate the approximate location for the detectable warning surface for each curb ramp type.



Typical placement of detectable warning surface on sloping ramp run.



# DETECTABLE WARNINGS

# Detectable Warning Pavers

- 24. Furnish detectable warning pover units meeting all requirements of ASTM C-936, C-33. Lay in a two by two unit basket weave pattern or as directed.
- Lay full-size units first followed by closure units consisting of at least 25 percent of a full unit. Cut detectable warning power units using a power saw.

# Sidewalks

- 26. Provide clear ground space at operable parts, including pedestrian push buttons. Operable parts shall be placed within one or more reach ranges specified in TAS 308.
- 27. Place traffic signal or illumination poles, ground boxes, controller boxes, signs, drainage facilities and other items so as not to obstruct the pedestrian access route or clear ground space.
- 28. Street grades and cross slopes shall be as shown elsewhere in the plans.
- 29. Changes in level greater than 1/4 inch are not permitted
- 30. The least passible grade should be used to maximize accessibility. The running slope of sidewalks and crosswalks within the public right of way may follow the grade of the parallel roadway. Where a continuous grade greater than 5% must be provided, handrails may be desirable to improve accessibility. Handrails may also be needed to protect pedestrians from potentially hazardous conditions. If provided, handrails shall comply with TAS 505.
- Handrail extensions shall not protrude into the usable landing area or into intersecting pedestrian routes.
- 32. Briveways and turnouts shall be constructed and paid for in accordance with Item
  —Intersections, Briveways and fundats", Sidewalks shall be constructed and paid for
  in accordance with Item, "Sidewalks".
- 33. Sidewalk details are shown elsewhere in the plans.




# PLACEMENT OF STREET FIXTURES



When an obstruction of a height greater than 27" from the surface would create a protrusion of more than 4" into the pedestrian circulation area, construct additional curb or foundation at the bottom to provide a maximum 4" overhang.



Protruding objects of a height ≤ 27" are detectable by cane and do not require additional treatment.

DETECTION BARRIER FOR VERTICAL CLEARANCE < 80"






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
SKEWED INTERSECTION WITH "LARGE" RADIUS




SKEWED INTERSECTION WITH "SMALL" RADIUS



NORMAL INTERSECTION WITH "SMALL" RADIUS




AT INTERSECTION W/FREE RIGHT TURN & ISLAND
