Our truck beds stand the test of time, because over the years we have never stopped looking for new ways to innovate. We study all aspects of every service body we produce to ensure we stand ahead of the competition. The crane option you have chosen to go with is a industry leader because we are the only manufacturer who installs the crane to our unique torq-isolator crane support system. This system, which is proprietary to Knapheide, transfers lift forces into the full length torsion box subframe and outriggers, not the side compartments. The reinforced rear vertical side compartment is independent of all other side compartments. This eliminates flexing and twisting of the side packs. This ensures the crane has the best footing possible versus simply bolting it to the service body. Service bodies are built strong using high quiality steel; however, as strong as this may be, we have determined this is not the best way to mount a crane. By mounting the crane to our torq-isolator this allows the crane to utilize the full truck weight as a counterbalance along with the outriggers. We have determined that utilizing this torq-isolator will save the service body from twisting and torquing, which over time can severely damage and/or destroy the service body. Knapheide has been the leader in service body industry, and family owned since 1848. We pride ourselves in our ability to continue to innovate and as always we never settle.
