**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PFLUGERVILLE, TEXAS
APPROVING THE SELECTION OF QUALIFIED
CONSTRUCTION MATERIAL TESTING (CMT) CONSULTANTS
FOR FUTURE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS, AND
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE
PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENTS WITH THE
SELECTED FIRMS**

WHEREAS, the City of Pflugerville, Texas (“City”) continues to invest in transportation, roadway, drainage, water, wastewater, reclaimed water, and parks infrastructure through its Capital Improvement Program, as approved by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, construction material testing services are essential to verify compliance with project plans, specifications, state standards, industry standards (*e.g.*, ASTM, AASHTO), and regulatory requirements, while ensuring the quality, safety, and long-term performance of public infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the City issued Request for Qualifications (“RFQ”) No. 2026-006 seeking Statements of Qualifications from firms experienced in providing Construction Material Testing (CMT) services for municipal infrastructure projects; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the RFQ was to establish a pool of qualified firms capable of providing professional construction material testing services on an as-needed basis for future City Capital Improvement Projects, with consultant assignments based on technical qualifications, project-specific expertise, workload, and availability; and

WHEREAS, a Selection Committee consisting of City staff evaluated the Statements of Qualifications using the published evaluation criteria, including project manager experience, firm capacity and resources, comparable project experience, organizational structure, project approach, and technical expertise, and subsequently conducted interviews with its highest-ranked firms; and

WHEREAS, based upon the evaluation process and interview results, the Selection Committee recommends the following firms as the most qualified to provide Construction Material Testing services to the City:

- Kleinfelder
- Terracon
- Atlas Technical Consultants
- Ninyo & Moore
- Intertek PSI; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to establish a pool of qualified consultants to support timely delivery of future Capital Improvement Projects while maintaining flexibility to assign services based upon each project's scope, schedule, complexity, and technical requirements; and

WHEREAS, City will negotiate individual Professional Services Agreements and project-specific work authorizations with the selected firms on an add-needed basis in accordance with the Texas Professional Services Procurement Act, Chapter 2254 of the Texas Government Code, City purchasing policies, and available project funding;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PFLUGERVILLE:

SECTION 1. The above recitals are found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein for all purposes.

SECTION 2. City Council approves the selection of the following firms as qualified Construction Material Testing (CMT) consultants for future City of Pflugerville Capital Improvement Projects:

- Kleinfelder
- Terracon
- Atlas Technical Consultants
- Ninyo & Moore
- Intertek PSI

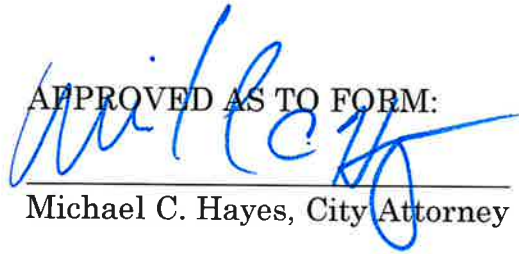

that consultant assignments will be made based on project needs, technical qualifications, consultant availability, and the best interests of the City.
