## **RESOLUTION NO. 1819-20-11-24-0785**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PFLUGERVILLE, TEXAS MAKING ADDITIONAL APPOINTMENTS TO THE CHARTER REVIEW COMMISSION

**WHEREAS**, Section 11.11 of the Pflugerville Home Rule Charter requires the appointment of a charter review commission two years after the adoption of the charter and every five years thereafter; and

**WHEREAS**, the charter review commission must contain at least 13 members, and not more than 20 members, with three members appointed by the mayor, two members appointed by each of the council members and the remaining members appointed by the majority vote of the council; and

**WHEREAS**, Pursuant to Section 11.11 of the Pflugerville Home Rule Charter, the City Council created a Charter Review Commission on November 10, 2020 and appointed 15 members; and

**WHEREAS**, Councilmember Doug Weiss appointed Darryl Houston to the Charter Review Commission on November 10, 2020 and as a current member of the Tax Reinvestment Zone No. One Board, Mr. Houston has declined the appointment; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds it appropriate to consider appointing up to five additional members to the Charter Review Commission and to allow Councilmember Doug Weiss to name a replacement appointment.

## NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PFLUGERVILLE, TEXAS, THAT:
