Scope of Services

- Replacement of membrane modules for Train 3 that were last replaced in 2014.
- □ Scope would also include replacing plastic components that are original to the train from original installation in 2005.






Autopsy Report – Train 3

- Suez was contacted to perform an autopsy report of Train 3 in January 2020 to evaluate the damage that the membranes had sustained.
- The current damage is due to zebra mussel shell pieces that had "sliced" the membrane modules over the course of summer 2019.
- The damage is severe enough to warrant a full replacement as repair couldn't guarantee that the membranes would be usable to be within TCEQ guidelines.











Justification

- Replacement of Train 3 allows the WTP to be able to have flexible operation during peak summer demand in the event another membrane train is down for maintenance.
- The new membrane modules will be installed but not used for treatment until the strainers are moved to ensure that they are not damaged in the interim.
- Strainers should be installed before peak summer demand. (Mid-June)
- If Train 3 membranes modules are not replaced, we run the risk to be unable to meet peak summer demand in the event of another membrane train goes down.



Sole Source Purchase



- Staff has complied with all state procurement laws.
- The price for the replacement modules through ZENON Environmental Corporation (also known as SUEZ) is guaranteed for 20 years subject to adjustment for inflation. This price is guaranteed until 2023.
