

(B) When signs are erected within temporary construction zones reading substantially, “no parking, tow-away zone,” it shall hereafter be unlawful for any person to park or stand any vehicle or trailer on those parts of streets at any time. The City Secretary shall keep on file a schedule of temporary construction zones as approved by City Council.

(C) When signs are erected on public streets specifically designated for parades or special events hosted by the City reading substantially, “no parking, tow-away zone,” it shall hereafter be unlawful for any person to park or stand any vehicle or trailer on those parts of streets at any time. The City Secretary shall keep on file a schedule of special events with designated no parking, tow-away zones as approved by City Council.

(D) The city manager or his designee is directed to cause to be towed away any vehicle found parked or standing in violation of this section; and the owner of such vehicle shall be civilly liable to the person doing such towing for the reasonable cost thereof.

Section 3. Severability. If any provision of this Ordinance is illegal, invalid, or unenforceable under present or future laws, the remainder of this Ordinance will not be affected and, in lieu of each illegal, invalid, or unenforceable provision, a provision as similar in terms to the illegal, invalid, or unenforceable provision as is possible and is legal, valid, and enforceable will be added to this Ordinance.

Section 4. Repealer. This ordinance shall be cumulative of all other ordinances of the City of Pflugerville, and this ordinance shall not operate to repeal or affect any other ordinances of the City of Pflugerville except insofar as the provisions thereof might be inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, in which event such conflicting provisions, if any, are hereby repealed.

Section 5. Penalty. A violation of this Ordinance shall be a Class C Misdemeanor with a fine amount not to exceed \$500.00, as provided in Section 71.99 of the City of Pflugerville Code of Ordinances.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance will take effect upon its adoption by the City Council in accordance with Section 3.15(d) of the City Charter.
