



Equity Pillars


- **Economic Equity**: Free WIFI and computers, laptop and hotspot lending, free classes and craft kits, free DigiT cards to every child in the district, resume help, small business resources, etc.
- **Health and Wellness**: Health screenings and vaccination clinics, free physical and electronic resources, programs and presentations, lunch and learn for seniors, blood drives, etc.
- Social Justice: Voter registration applications, voter drives, polling place, programs on socially relevant topics, cultural programs and resources, recognition of underrepresented populations, materials from underrepresented populations, internship for underrepresented youth, etc.
- Education: Free access to physical and electronic resources, free online classes, ASL and ESL classes, career and job resources, Princeton Review Practice exams, partnerships with PfISD, Sora, Career Online High School
- Governmental Oversight: We answer to the community, city, state and state and national organizations.









Pandemic Survey






Did you use Curbside Service?




Did you use mobile printing?

- Your staff is awesome! You have some unique services that I'm so happy to have been able to participate in, like the seed library.




