Re: Consider for approval a resolution authorizing the City Manager to apply for and accept, if awarded, a BG- Rifle-Resistant Body Armor Grant Program (BAGP) award for \$35,736.00 from the Office of the Governor for the purchase of 24 grant-compliant vests. There is no funding match for this grant from the City. Approval is also requested to authorize the City Manager to sign all necessary documents upon final approval of the City Attorney.

I. Background

- A. The Pflugerville Police Department requires protective vests for its uniformed officers.
- B. Deadline for filing the application with the Office of the Governor is February 28, 2019.
- C. In the fourth quarter of 2019 the City will be notified by the Office of the Governor of the award approval decision.
- D. To access the grant funding, City Council must authorize the City Manager to apply for and accept the grant award if received.
