**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PFLUGERVILLE, TEXAS,  
AMENDING RESOLUTION REQUIRING THE WEARING  
OF MASKS IN CITY FACILITIES**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Pflugerville, Texas approved Resolution 1914-21-09-14-0922 to protect the public health and welfare of the community and those individuals who attend, visit, or work in city facilities and help control further transmission of COVID-19 by requiring masks be worn within indoor city facilities any time Austin-Travis County is placed under COVID-19 Stages 3-5; and

**WHEREAS**, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) has provided the COVID-19 Community Levels and both Travis County and Williamson County are categorized as Low; and

**WHEREAS**, the CDC stated under the Low category to wear a mask based on your personal preference and personal risk;

**NOW THEREFORE**, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PFLUGERVILLE, TEXAS, THAT:

1. Face covering requirements as stated in Resolution 1914-21-09-14-0922 will remain in place any time the CDC categorizes Travis or Williamson County as High.

**PASSED, APPROVED, AND ADOPTED** the City Council of City of Pflugerville, Texas at a meeting on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2022, at which a quorum was present, and for which due notice was given pursuant to Chapter 551, Texas Government Code.
