#### **Regular Meeting**

#### 1. Call to order

Mayor Jeff Coleman called the meeting to order at 7:04 p.m. Councilmembers Brad Marshall, Darelle White, Starlet Sattler, and Victor Gonzales were in attendance. Councilmember Wayne Cooper was absent. # 2. Opening

Mayor Coleman led those in attendance in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.

He stated that the City would now be under 60 cents. Mr. White made a motion to approve the property tax rate of .599. Mr. Marshall seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion carried.
