##### 3A Receive a semiannual report regarding the progress of the City's Capital Improvement Plan.

Ms. Morrison introduced the Semiannual report regarding the progress of the City's Capital Improvement Plan. She went over the program overview. Ms. Morrison said there are 61 active projects, of which 38 are in the Design Phase and 23 are in the Construction Phase. Mr. Pritchett went over the water and wastewater CIP projects. He provided updates on the 4 largest projects, the Water Treatment Plant Expansion, the Secondary Colorado River Raw Water Line, the Wilbarger Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant, and the Wilbarger Creek Wastewater Interceptor. Mr. Groeschel discussed the Transportation CIP projects. He provided an update of projects under construction and timeframes for upcoming projects. Mr. Achee went over the Parks CIP projects. He discussed the Multi-Generational Recreation Center; it will be the second largest in the State of Texas. He highlighted some of the features such as the indoor turf with ramp and the adventure tract. He also gave updates of other parks in the CIP by providing visuals and timeframes.
