**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PFLUGERVILLE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZED BY SECTION 418.108(b) OF THE TEXAS GOVERNMENT CODE CONSENTING TO, CONTINUING, AND RENEWING THE MAYOR’S DISASTER DECLARATION ISSUED ON MARCH 4, 2026, IMMINENT PUBLIC WATER SUPPLY FAILURE**

**WHEREAS**, on March 4, 2026, the Mayor, by proclamation, issued a *Declaration of Disaster* regarding an imminent public water supply failure (“Disaster Declaration”); and

**WHEREAS**, City Council has determined that continuing and renewing the Disaster Declaration is necessary to protect the residents of the City and its water customers; and

**WHEREAS**, City Council finds that it is in the public interest for it to consent to the Mayor’s continuation and renewal of the March 4, 2026, Disaster Declaration, pursuant to authority granted by the Texas Disaster Act of 1975, Chapter 418, Texas Government Code;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PFLUGERVILLE, TEXAS:**

**SECTION ONE.** The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein and made findings of fact.

**SECTION TWO.** City Council consents to the extension and renewal of the local state of disaster for the City pursuant to Section 418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code. The Mayor issued a Declaration of Disaster on March 4, 2026. The City of Pflugerville Declaration of Disaster (Continued and Renewed) is attached as **Exhibit A**.

**SECTION THREE.** Pursuant to Section 418.108(c) of the Government Code, this extension and renewal of the Disaster Declaration shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the City Secretary.

**SECTION FOUR.** Pursuant to Section 418.108(d) of the Government Code, this renewal and continuation of the Disaster Declaration continues the activation of the appropriate response, recovery, and rehabilitation aspects of the City under the Travis County Emergency Management plan and authorizes the furnishing of aid and assistance under the declaration and order.

**SECTION FIVE.** The Disaster Declaration is effective until terminated.

**SECTION SIX.** The terms and provisions of this Resolution and the Disaster Declaration shall be deemed to be severable and that if any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or word shall be declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or word, and the remainder of this Resolution and Disaster Declaration shall continue in full force and effect the same as if such invalid or unconstitutional provision had never been a part hereof.
