

**MAYOR'S PROCLAMATION  
DECLARING PFLUGERVILLE PINK PFRIDAYS  
IN OBSERVANCE OF BREAST CANCER AWARENESS MONTH  
IN THE CITY OF PFLUGERVILLE

**WHEREAS**, the citizens of Pflugerville value the benefits of good health as the key component of a long, productive and fulfilling life and proudly support observances that focus public attention on crucial health issues, such as Breast Cancer Awareness Month; and

**WHEREAS**, breast cancer is the second most common kind of cancer in women with research showing that about 1 in 8 women born today in the United States will get breast cancer at some point; and

**WHEREAS**, the good news is that many women can survive breast cancer if it is found and treated early. A mammogram – the screening test for breast cancer – can help find breast cancer early when it's easier to treat; and

**WHEREAS**, Breast Cancer Awareness Month is a chance to raise awareness about the importance of early detection of breast cancer. Make a difference! Spread the word about mammograms and encourage communities, organizations, families, and individuals to get involved and participate with Pflugerville each Pink Pfriday in October.

**NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED THAT I, MAYOR JEFF COLEMAN**, do hereby declare that each Friday in October 2015 shall be observed as Pflugerville Pink Pfriday in observance of BREAST CANCER AWARENESS MONTH in the City of Pflugerville.
