WHEREAS, In 2006, he received the Ruben Fuentes Award for the Mariachi Music Hall of Fame; and

WHEREAS, In 2014, he was the recipient of the Lifetime Achievement Award in Music at the Emma S. Barrientos Mexican Cultural Center; and

WHEREAS, In 2013, Zeke served as the Founder and Director of the First University of Texas at Austin Longhorn Mariachi Camp for high school students.
