


Approving a Storm Water Facilities Maintenance Covenant, License and Agreement for the Cardinal Crossing Phase 3 Condo development located generally in between Black Locust and Pflugerville Parkway at 601 East Pflugerville Parkway and authorizing the City Manager to execute the agreement.



## Overview


- The Cardinal Crossing Phase 3 Condo development will incorporate an aboveground detention pond to detain storm water runoff from the property.
- This agreement between the property owner, Cardinal Crossing Condominium Community, Inc. and the City of Pflugerville spells out the owner's responsibility to maintain the proposed drainage facilities in perpetuity.
- The City Attorney has reviewed and approved the Agreement instrument as to form





## Background

- This agreement spells out the owner's responsibility to maintain the drainage facilities in perpetuity. Inspection and maintenance will be the sole responsibility of the property owner.
- In the event the system is not being properly maintained, this agreement gives the City the right to enter the property and perform any inspection, monitoring, operation, maintenance, replacement, upgrade or repair necessary for the duration of such activities and allows for the City to recover the costs associated with such actions.
- Reference Part III, Section B.4.b.3 of the General TPDES (Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System), Phase II Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) permit, which requires that the City require the owner or operator of a site to develop and implement a maintenance plan





## Recommended Action
