Discussion regarding the Aspire 2040 Comprehensive Plan.

Mayor Gonzales opened the item for discussion. Ms. Barron stated the presentation is for the final draft of Aspire Pflugerville 2040 Comprehensive Plan. Ms. Barron introduced Chance Sparks with Freese and Nichols. Mr. Sparks provided information about the process of creating the comp plan over COVID, information about vision and guiding principles, and discussed the comprehensive plan chapters. Mr. Sparks discussed community engagement and answered questions from council stating it was a strong showing from the community. Mr. Sparks continued discussion regarding land use, development, and growth. Discussion followed regarding higher education institutions. Mr. Sparks provided information about fiscal analysis, transportation and mobility, traffic challenges, and answered questions from council. Ms. Barron provided information about existing and future neighborhoods working together to meet the vision of the comprehensive plan. Mr. Sparks discussed infrastructure, community facilities, and public services. Discussion followed regarding the changing needs and expectations following COVID.
