WHEREAS, cities, towns and counties have a critical role to play to help save the monarch butterfly, and the City of Pflugerville Parks & Recreation Department is taking steps to create and foster butterfly habitat; and

WHEREAS, every citizen of Pflugerville can make a difference for the monarch by planting native milkweed and nectar plants to provide habitat for the monarch and pollinators in locations where people live, work, learn, play and worship; and

WHEREAS, on behalf of the citizens of Pflugerville, I am honored to join other Mayors from across the United States by signing the National Wildlife Federation's Mayor's Monarch Pledge; and I encourage other city officials across our great nation to take a stand with me so that the monarch butterfly will once again flourish across the continent.
