**Residency** is based on living in the city limits of Pflugerville and paying all applicable city of Pflugerville taxes. A **family** is defined as a maximum of two adults, ages 19 and older, and minor children residing at the same address. Full-time **college students** (ages 19-23) residing at the same address also qualify as family members. Proof of residency by Texas driver's license or city utility bill may be requested by the Recreation Center staff, along with proof of college enrollment.

### **Payment Policy**

Payments for classes and programs offered at the Recreation Center can be made by:

Some classes offer payment plans. See class descriptions for specifics.

**Refunds** of paid fees will be given if a class does not meet minimum enrollment requirements and an alternate class cannot be found. In most cases, minumum enrollment is five students.

**Cancellations** will be accepted up to one week before the start of a session. A \$7 administrative fee will be withheld from fees paid. If cancellation occurs within 7 days of the start or after start of a class, NO refunds will be given.

### **Dance Classes - Descriptions**

#### Music & Movement: Ages 2 and older

Parent participation is welcome in this 45-minute class. In an environment rich with instruments, props and costumed characters, students explore movement and music through song, dance, rhythm clapping, and playing simple instruments. Students wear comfortable clothes (dancewear optional), tap shoes, sock feet or ballet shoes.

#### Combo: Ages 3-4 and 4-5

This one-hour class combines ballet, tap, and a bit of tumbling in an environment rich with props, music and costumed characters. Activities in this fun-filled class teach developmental and age-appropriate skills, encourage creativity, and help the students develop rhythm and coordination. Girls wear any color leotard and tights, black tap shoes, pink ballet shoes. Boys wear sweatpants or other stretch pants, any color T-shirt, black tap shoes, black ballet shoes.

#### **Super Combo Block: Ages 4-5**

Ballet, tap, tumbling, theater and music fill a stimulating two-hour program with excitement and learning for the students, while the parents get enough time to buy groceries or run errands! Snack time, a read-aloud book and occasional costumed characters complete the fun. Students wear dancewear or comfortable clothing, pink (girls) or black (boys) ballet shoes, and black tap shoes.

#### Ballet & Tap 1: Ages 5-7

One-hour class focuses on ballet and tap, with plenty of fun to keep things exciting. Activities in this class teach real skills, encourage creativity, and help develop rhythm and coordination. Girls wear any color leotard and tights, black tap shoes, pink ballet shoes. Boys wear sweatpants or other stretch pants, any color T-shirt, black tap shoes, black ballet shoes.

#### Ballet II, Tap II, Ballet III & Tap III

Forty-five minute classes in specific disciplines allow students with previous training to expand their knowledge with real skills in exciting and engaging classes. Girls wear black leotard and any color tights, black tap shoes, pink ballet shoes. Boys wear black sweatpants or other stretch pants, solid color Teshirt, black tap shoes, black ballet shoes.

### **Pflugerville Dog Park**

19417 Murchison Ridge Trail Hours: Dawn to 10 p.m. Limit 2 dogs per person Dogs ages 4 months and older

The Dog Park is located on a 2.5-acre tract that includes a pear orchard, demonstration gardens and Purple Martin village. It is fenced and includes separate areas for large dogs and small dogs (less than 30 pounds in weight). All dogs must be leashed when entering and leaving the park, have current vaccinations, be healthy and free of contagious diseases and parasites. Aggressive dogs must be leashed and immediately removed. All dogs must be under an adult's control, in view of and within voice control of owner/handler at all times. No choke chains, prong, spiked or shock collars permitted. No dogs in heat are permitted. Owners/handlers must pick up their dogs' waste.

No food, drink, smoking, glass or metal containers, bicycles, skateboards, inline skates or motorized vehicles in the park.

**Please note:** Owner waives liability to the city for any injury or damage caused by dogs or humans while using the park.

Children ages 12 and younger must be under adult supervision. Running within the park's boundaries and chasing dogs are prohibited.

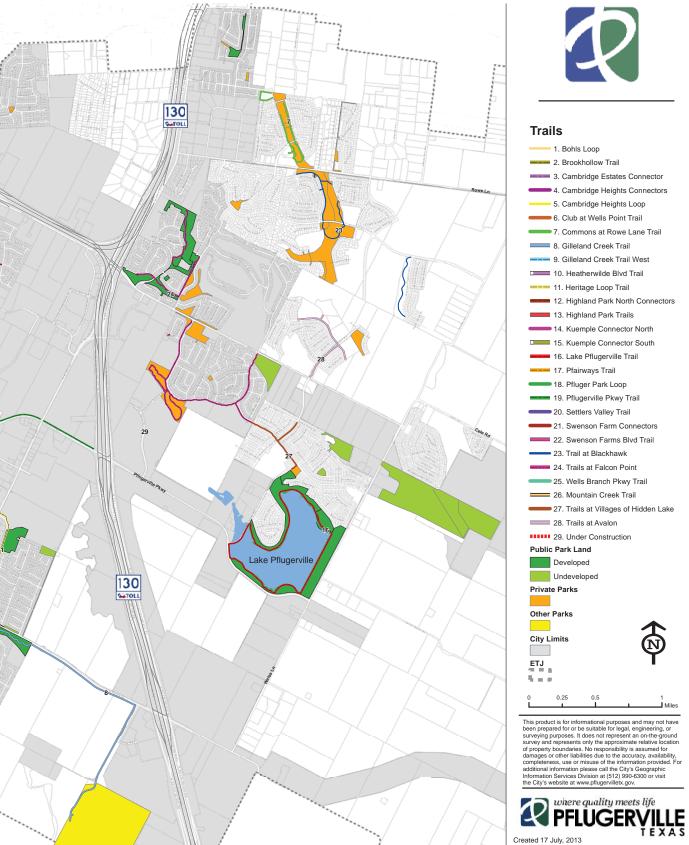

**Program requirements:** Only plants listed on the Drop-By-Drop list qualify for the rebate.

\* Only plants purchased after the submittal and approval of an application are eligible for a rebate. \* Plants must be planted on the property owned by the qualifying applicant. \* Plants located in public street rights-of-way are not elibigle for a rebate.

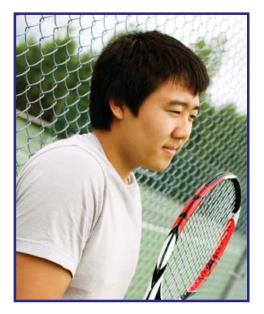

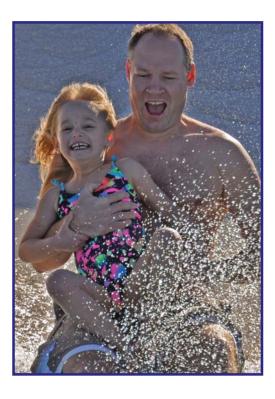

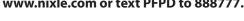
