

## **Colorado River Raw Water Line Overview**



- 15 miles of 42-inch water pipeline
- Colorado River Intake Pump Station Improvements designed for capacity of 21 Million Gallons per Day at buildout
- 12,000 acre feet/year water supply increase
- Increases supply to maintain levels of Lake Pflugerville for recreation, aquatic habitat and water quality
- Pursuing Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) Clean
  Water State Revolving Fund participation



## **Scope of Services**

- Project management
- Coordination with CMAR
- Developing and updating program schedule, budget and risk register
- Agency and regulatory support
- Design phase meetings and agency document review
- Design and bid phase support services for:
  - Three (3) long-lead equipment packages
  - Pump station design package
  - Two (2) pipeline design packages

- Supplemental services (Included in the scope only to be used with authorization of staff, if determined to be needed)
  - Texas Water Development Board support
  - Water supply planning support
  - Support for physical modeling of pump station improvements
