



**PROCLAMATION
DECLARING NATIONAL PUBLIC
SAFETY TELECOMMUNICATORS
WEEK IN THE CITY OF
PFLUGERVILLE
APRIL 12-18, 2026**

WHEREAS, emergencies can occur at anytime requiring police, fire or emergency medical services; and

WHEREAS, when an emergency occurs, the prompt response of law enforcement, firefighters, and paramedics is critical to the protection of life and preservation of property; and

WHEREAS, the safety of our police officers is dependent upon the speed, quality and accuracy of information obtained from citizens who telephone the Pflugerville Police Department's Communication Division; and

WHEREAS, public safety dispatchers are the first and most critical contact our community has with emergency services; and

WHEREAS, public safety dispatchers are the single vital link for our law enforcement personnel by obtaining vital information, monitoring their activities by radio and providing them with this information ensuring their safety ; and

WHEREAS, the public safety dispatchers of the Pflugerville Police Department's Communication Division have contributed substantially to the safety of our community and police officers, apprehension of criminals, containment of dangerous situations, and treatment of patients; and

WHEREAS, the Pflugerville Police Department's Communication Division has exhibited compassion, understanding and professionalism in their service to our citizens and police officers; and

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that I, Doug Weiss, Mayor of the City of Pflugerville, Texas, do hereby proclaim the week of April 12 to April 18, 2026 as National Public Safety Telecommunicators Week in the City of Pflugerville and encourage all citizens to join me in honoring the men and women whose diligence and professionalism keep our citizens and community safe.
