#### Worksession

##### 3A. [2025-0228](#) Discussion regarding Lake Pflugerville safety and future of the park.

Mr. Weiss opened the item for discussion. Mr. Mize discussed the different uses of the lake and provided information about the lake's history. Mr. Mize stated it is growing in popularity and reviewed the usage of the park over the last three years including city events and permitted events. Mr. Mize discussed use by residents during peak and non-peak times and provided information about how the lake compares to other lake parks. Mr. Mize stated Lake Pflugerville is the only free walk-up beach in the area and discussed the lake regulations and safety protocols. Discussion followed regarding infrastructure upgrades and bond considerations. Mr. Achee discussed parking considerations including gates and expansion. Discussion followed regarding what was included in the bond. Discussion followed regarding the impact of expanding the beach and parking availability. Mr. Mize discussed possible changes to regulations to mitigate some of the current concerns.
