WHEREAS , the City Council adopted a standard professional services agreement in 2010 fo use by the City when contracting for professional services;

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the City Manager and/or City Attorney can adequately balance the risks and benefits associated with the terms and conditions for professional services when preparing a contract for City approval and modify those as deemed necessary and appropriate, especially those related to indemnity and defense costs in the event of a claim or cause of action arising from or related to a contract; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council finds authorizing the City Manager and/or City Attorney to negotiate terms and conditions within the City Council approved professional services agreement for the City of Pflugerville, Texas is appropriate under the circumstances; and,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PFLUGERVILLE, TEXAS THAT:

- 1) The City Manager and/or City Attorney are authorized to negotiate and modify terms and conditions within the City Council approved professional services agreement as provided and consistent with the recitals of this Resolution;
- 2) The recitals of this Resolution are adopted as if recited verbatim.
