A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PFLUGERVILLE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZED BY SECTION 418.108(b) OF THE TEXAS GOVERNMENT CODE CONSENTING TO, CONTINUING, AND RENEWING THE MAYOR'S DISASTER DECLARATION ISSUED ON MARCH 4, 2026, IMMINENT PUBLIC WATER SUPPLY FAILURE

WHEREAS, on March 4, 2026, the Mayor, by proclamation, issued a *Declaration of Disaster* regarding an imminent public water supply failure (“Disaster Declaration”); and

WHEREAS, on March 10, 2026, City Council adopted Resolution No. 2259-26-03-10-1408 which (i) consented to the Mayor’s issuance of the Disaster Declaration; and, (ii) consented to the continuation and renewal of the declaration until May 4, 2026, pursuant to Section 418.108(b), Texas Government Code; and

WHEREAS, on April 28, 2026, City Council consented to the continuation and renewal of the Disaster Declaration by its adoption of Resolution No. 2266-26-04-28-1415; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has determined, and Council hereby consents, that continuing and renewing the Disaster Declaration until July 15, 2026, is necessary to protect the residents of the City and its water customers; and

WHEREAS, City Council finds that it is in the public interest for it to consent to the Mayor’s continuation and renewal of the March 4, 2026, Disaster Declaration, pursuant to authority granted by the Texas Disaster Act of 1975, Chapter 418, Texas Government Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PFLUGERVILLE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein and made findings of fact.

SECTION 2. City Council consents to the extension and renewal of the local state of disaster for the City pursuant to Section 418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code. The Mayor issued a Declaration of Disaster on March 4, 2026, which was subsequently renewed and consented to by Council on March 10, 2026 (Reso. No. 2259-26-03-10-1408) and April 28, 2026 (Reso. No. 2266-26-04-28-1415). The City of

Pflugerville Declaration of Disaster (Continued and Renewed) is attached as **Exhibit A**.

SECTION 3. Pursuant to Section 418.108(c) of the Government Code, this extension and renewal of the Disaster Declaration shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the City Secretary.

SECTION 4. Pursuant to Section 418.108(d) of the Government Code, this renewal and continuation of the Disaster Declaration continues the activation of the appropriate response, recovery, and rehabilitation aspects of the City under the Travis County Emergency Management plan and authorizes the furnishing of aid and assistance under the declaration and order.

SECTION 5. This Disaster Declaration shall terminate on July 15, 2026.

SECTION 6. The terms and provisions of this Resolution and the Disaster Declaration shall be deemed to be severable and that if any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or word shall be declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or word, and the remainder of this Resolution and Disaster Declaration shall continue in full force and effect the same as if such invalid or unconstitutional provision had never been a part hereof.


