Worksession

1. Call to Order

Mayor Pro Tem Kimberly Holiday called the worksession to order at 12:00pm. Councilmembers Jonathan Coffman, Ceasar Ruiz, Melody Ryan, and David Rogers were in attendance. Councilmember Rudy Metayer joined the meeting at 12:06pm. Mayor Victor Gonzales was not in attendance.

3. Regular Agenda

3A. [2025-0960](#) Discussion regarding license plate readers.

Mayor Pro Tem Holiday opened the item for discussion. Ms. Breland discussed how license plate readers are used and the City's public portal. Mr. Rogers discussed hearing some concerns about license plate readers. Kevin Cutler with Flock provided information about how they gather evidence free from bias and how the data is used. Mr. Cutler answered questions from council regarding how the readers work. Mr. Coffman asked about sharing the data with other agencies and how it is connected. Kraig Gardner with Flock stated Flock does not have any partnerships with federal agencies and discussed the process of sharing data. Lt. Summers provided information about the city's data and discuss followed regarding potential misuse of data. Mr. Gardner discussed the reviews and audits that identify any misuse. Mr. Ruiz left the worksession at 12:34pm. Amanda Spees with Flock discussed policy implementation in those cases. Lt. Summers answered questions from council regarding agencies the city shares data with. Mr. Gardner discussed the importance of these discussions, ethics teams, and making changes to the system based on agency needs. Mr. Cutler provided information about successes in Pflugerville. Ms. Ryan asked for data showing incident numbers across the board. Discussion followed regarding the impact of license plate readers.
