

**MAYOR'S PROCLAMATION
DECLARING JUNE 15, 2015
AS RIDE TO WORK DAY
IN THE CITY OF PFLUGERVILLE**

WHEREAS, motorcycles and scooters are efficient, economical, and beneficial forms of personal transportation; and

WHEREAS, motorcycles and scooters use comparatively less fuel, cause less pollution and have less harmful impacts on our infrastructure than automobiles; and

WHEREAS, motorcycles and scooters take up less space on roadways and require only a fraction of space taken by other vehicles to park; and

WHEREAS, the price of fossil fuels is growing and the supply is diminishing; and

WHEREAS, the use of fossil fuels continues to damage our health by adding to pollution and contributing to global warming; and

WHEREAS, the 24th annual worldwide "Ride to Work Day" on June 15, 2015 is expected to be one of the largest ever with some projecting an additional one million added riders on this day; and

WHEREAS, motorcycling and scooting clubs and citizens in the community will participate by riding to work on this day;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Jeff Coleman, do hereby proclaim June 15, 2015, to be "Ride to Work Day" in the City of Pflugerville.
