WHEREAS, the Pflugerville Parks and Recreation Department offers Learn-to-Swim classes, private swim lessons, and encourages safe practices around all bodies of water in the City of Pflugerville;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Victor Gonzales, do hereby declare May 2025, as **WATER SAFETY MONTH** in the City of Pflugerville, and encourage all residents to register for water safety and CPR/AED classes, always have a "water watcher" supervising while others are in the water, wear U.S. Coast Guard-approved life jackets, secure residential pools with adequate barriers, and create an emergency plan and prepare how to react if a water emergency happens.
