Worksession

1. Call to order

2A. [2019-7719](#) Discussion regarding Pflugerville Fiscal Impact Model and Land Use Analysis project. Mr. Fletcher provided an introduction. Felix Landry, Verdunity, presented a land use fiscal analysis and discussed with Council.

2B. [2019-7743](#) 1.) Executive Session Item: Deliberation regarding real property pursuant to Chapter 551.072 of the Texas Government Code regarding the purchase, exchange, lease, and/or value of real property for a 0.7748-acre parcel in the Pflugerville Central Business District. Mayor Gonzales announced that the City Council was retiring to executive session for discussion on the item. He read the item and retired to executive session.
