Summer Reading Program Highlights

June and July

Our annual reading contest was hosted online through Beanstack!

New this summer was our Guest Display incentive. One reader randomly drawn from each of the 4 teams was invited to create an exhibit for the display cabinet in the Great Hall.

Two prizes of Ultimate Reading Bundle Baskets were up for grabs in the Pflugerville Public Library's Summer Reading Program! The first-place finishers who logged the most reading hours (across all 4 teams), in both youth and adult categories, won the ultimate reader's prize basket!

The Green Team won the 2026 challenge with an average of 2,566 reading minutes per teammate. To honor the win, the library featured special verdant book displays outside the children's and teens' areas. An adult participant named Britt won a grand prize by reading 19,199 minutes. We had 486,288 minutes and 542 registrants this year! Congratulations to everyone who participated!
