The CDBG program provides annual grants on a formula basis to entitled communities to develop viable urban communities by providing decent housing and a suitable living environment, and by expanding economic opportunities, principally for low to moderate income persons.

## 2020 Project Priority

<u>Infrastructure</u> – Fund approximately \$243,995 in infrastructure projects that are in areas defined as low-moderate income.

<u>Programs</u> – Park and Recreation Scholarship Program (\$20,000/year); provide scholarships to 100 low-moderate income children annually to participate in Pfun Camp or other related Parks and Recreation Program

- Provide utility payment assistance for low-moderate income residents that have been impacted by COVID-19 (\$138,241/2 year period)
- Provide 15 seniors with a tablet, internet for a year and training on how to use the tablet to access the internet (15 seniors/\$20,000)
