Re: Consider for approval a resolution authorizing the City Manager to apply for and accept, if awarded, a 2023 Project Safe Neighborhood Grant award for \$110,726.50 from the Office of the Governor for the purchase of equipment and overtime funding for project support personnel to establish a license plate reader program for crime prevention, investigation and resolution of crime within the City of Pflugerville. There is no funding match for this grant from the City. Approval is also requested to authorize the City Manager to sign all necessary documents upon final approval of the City Attorney.

I. Background

- A. This will be a second-year grant.
- B. The Pflugerville Police Department is utilizing this funding to implement a license plate reader system to assist with crime prevention, investigation and resolution of crime within the City of Pflugerville along with personnel overtime compensation.
- C. The City currently has funding from the 2022 Project Safe Neighborhood grant to operate a system of this type. Currently one local HOA has installed one license plate reader which has already been utilized to assist with several investigations. This grant would assist the Department with establishing this equipment in strategic locations around the city.

II. Current Situation

- A. The Police Department seeks funding assistance from the 2023 Project Safe Neighborhood Grant award for \$110,726.50 to assist in the implementation of a license plate reader system. This is a one-year grant.
- B. There is no funding match for this grant.
- C. Deadline for CAPCOG review is February 3, 2022
- D. Deadline for filing the application with the Office of the Governor is February 10, 2022. The resolution will be added upon authorization.
- E. In the fourth quarter of 2022 the City will be notified by the Office of the Governor of the award approval decision.

F. To access the grant funding, City Council must authorize the City Manager to apply for and accept the grant award if received.

V. Recommendation

Approve the resolution authorizing the City Manager to apply for and accept, if awarded, the 2023 Project Safe Neighborhood Grant award for \$110,726.50.

PROJECT TO THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR**

WHEREAS, The City of Pflugerville City Council finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Pflugerville, Texas that the Pflugerville Police Department – 2023 Project Safe Neighborhood Grant project be operated for one year beginning fiscal year 2023; and

WHEREAS, The City of Pflugerville City Council agrees to provide applicable matching funds for the said project as required by the Project Safe Neighborhood Grant application; and

WHEREAS, The City of Pflugerville City Council agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds, the City of Pflugerville City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full.

WHEREAS, The City of Pflugerville City Council designates the City Manager as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.
