RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PFLUGERVILLE, TEXAS AMENDING BOUNDARIES AND ACCEPTING APPROXIMATELY 470.5 ACRES OF EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION FROM THE CITY OF MANOR

WHEREAS, it is in the interests of sound planning and regional cooperation that the City of Pflugerville and the City of Manor jointly establish extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ) boundaries between the two municipalities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pflugerville approved an exchange of extraterritorial jurisdiction and established extraterritorial boundaries with the City of Manor by Resolution No. 1136-08-08-12-8F on August 12, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pflugerville now finds it appropriate to amend those extraterritorial boundaries with the City of Manor and accept approximately 470.5 acres of additional extraterritorial jurisdiction; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PFLUGERVILLE, TEXAS:

That the City of Pflugerville hereby agrees to amend the boundaries of its extraterritorial jurisdiction by establishing the west side of Manda Carlson Road and across Manda Carlson Road to the south side of Sandeen Road as the eastern limit of the City of Pflugerville's extraterritorial jurisdiction; and hereby agrees to accept the corresponding additional territory of approximately 470.5 acres into the City of Pflugerville's extraterritorial jurisdiction as depicted on Exhibit A.
