NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, THAT I, Omar Peña, Mayor Pro Tem of the City of Pflugerville, do hereby declare the week of April 10 to April 16, 2016 as National Public Safety Telecommunicators Week in the City of Pflugerville and encourage all citizens to join me in honoring the men and women whose diligence and professionalism keep our citizens and community safe.
