

**MAYOR'S PROCLAMATION
DECLARING NOVEMBER 29,2022 AS PFLUGERVILLE LIBRARY DAY
IN THE CITY OF PFLUGERVILLE**

WHEREAS, in 1982 the first storefront was established on Railroad Avenue by the Friends of the Library.

WHEREAS, in 1982 the Library was staffed by volunteers and consisted mostly of donated books and other materials.

WHEREAS, in 1986 the Library moved to a larger facility on Third Street and the first professional librarian was hired; and

WHEREAS, The Friends of the Library continued to raise funds by running a thrift shop at Fifth and Pecan Street. In 1990, they purchased 1.6 acres at Pecan and 10th Street setting the stage for the next phase of the Library.; and

WHEREAS, In 1999, the Library moved to its current location with a formal dedication and guest speaker former First Lady and librarian, Laura Bush; and

WHEREAS, In May 2008, voters passed a bond to expand the library. The renovation was completed in 2013, providing the community with the building as it is today; and

WHEREAS, Today the library proudly serves over 300,000 visitors a year, is an annual recipient of Texas Municipal Library Association Achievement of Excellence in Libraries Award Winner, and a 2022 National Medal for Museum and Library Services Finalist.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that I, Victor Gonzales, Mayor of the City of Pflugerville, Texas, do hereby proclaim November 29th as Pflugerville Library Day in the City of Pflugerville, and urge Pflugerville residents to join me in extending sincere congratulations and gratitude to the Pflugerville Public Library for serving and enriching the lives of Pflugerville residents by providing a variety of intellectual, educational, recreational and cultural resources.
