**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PFLUGERVILLE, TEXAS
EXTENDING THE REQUIRED 60-DAY PUBLIC HEARING PERIOD REQUIRED BY
SUBCHAPTER 3.4 FOR A PROPOSED COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AMENDMENT
(2022-2-CPA).**

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission conducted a public hearing on July 17, 2023 for a Comprehensive Plan Amendment case known as the New Growth Comprehensive Plan Amendment (2022-2-CPA); and

WHEREAS, Subchapter 3.4, Procedures of the Unified Development Code requires City Council to act within 60 days of the public hearing to either adopt or reject the proposed amendment; and

WHEREAS, the Applicant submitted a request for postponement to City Staff requesting a 30 day extension on September 26, 2023; and

WHEREAS, Subchapter 3.7.3, Procedures allows for 30-day extension by Resolution of City Council; for a maximum of two 30-day extensions; and

WHEREAS, in order to prevent the request from becoming denied or withdrawn, the Applicant has requested a second 30-day extension so that first reading of the ordinance may be considered on November 14, 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PFLUGERVILLE:

That the City Council of the City of Pflugerville hereby approves a 30-day extension to allow for a public hearing and first reading of the ordinance to be considered on November 14, 2023.
