STATEMENT OF SERVICES

This **STATEMENT OF SERVICES** (“Statement”), effective as of April 19, 2021, is the statutorily required notice of the services that will be provided by **TRAVIS COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 2** (the “District”), a political subdivision of the State of Texas, organized and operating pursuant to the provisions of Section 48-e, Article III of the Texas Constitution and Chapter 775 of the Health and Safety Code, as amended (“H&S Code”) in the event of the creation of **TRAVIS COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 17** (the “Proposed District”). If created, the Proposed District will also be political subdivision of the State of Texas and will be organized and will operate pursuant to the provisions of Section 48-e, Article III of the Texas Constitution and Chapter 775 of the H&S Code.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the District is a duly organized emergency services district, created to protect life and health, and for such other purposes as determined by the District under Chapter 775 of the H&S Code, with full authority to carry out the objects of its creation; and

WHEREAS, under the provision of H&S Code §775.018(g), the District must provide this Statement to the Proposed District outlining the types of emergency services the District will provide in the overlapping territory in the event of the Proposed District’s creation; and

WHEREAS, the District has determined that it is in the best interest of the residents and property owners of the District to make this Statement in order to allow the Proposed District to provide services related to advanced life support (“ALS”) and emergency medical service ambulance transport (“Ambulance Transport”).

NOW, THEREFORE, the District states it will provide services within the District and the Proposed District as follows:


SERVICES PROVIDED

1. Fire Prevention, Fire-Fighting services and related powers and authority, including emergency response on all structure, grass, brush and other fires within the District on a 24-hour-per-day, seven-day-a-week basis;
2. Rescue services and related powers and authority, including emergency response on all emergency calls within the District on a 24-hour-per-day, seven-day-a-week basis;

3. All other services and powers that an emergency services district is authorized to provide or exercise under Chapter 775 of the Texas Health & Safety Code, except for services related to advanced life support ("ALS") and emergency medical service ambulance transport ("Ambulance Transport"), which may be provided by the Proposed District.


