

RESOLUTION NO:

SUPPORTING THE TRAVIS COUNTY SPONSORED APPLICATIONS TO THE CAPITAL AREA METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION'S 2028 – 2031 CALL FOR PROJECTS

WHEREAS, the Capital Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (CAMPO) issued a call for projects in October 2025 for eligible sponsors to apply for federal funding assistance through the Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG), the Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside (TASA), and the Carbon Reduction Program (CRP) funding programs; and

WHEREAS, the funds may be used for development and implementation of transportation projects that serve the six-county CAMPO region; and

WHEREAS, the Mobility Master Plan was approved on May 27, 2025, combining the Master Transportation Plan and Trails Master Plan to improve how residents navigate Pflugerville for transportation and recreation; and

WHEREAS, Travis County will sponsor and provide the required local match for the Wells Branch Parkway Phase IV, Immanuel Road, and East Pflugerville Parkway (Jesse Bohls Road) Corridor Plans that are partially located within the jurisdiction of the City of Pflugerville, and these Corridor Plans will result in a conceptual schematic of the preferred alternative for each Plan; and

WHEREAS, Travis County would be responsible for all non-reimbursable costs and 100% of overruns, if any, for County sponsored Corridor Plans that are awarded funding; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pflugerville believes that the Wells Branch Parkway Phase IV, Immanuel Road, and East Pflugerville Parkway (Jesse Bohls Road) Corridor Plans will be beneficial to improving transportation safety, mobility and accessibility within our jurisdictional boundaries,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT WE, THE CITY OF PFLUGERVILLE, do hereby support and concur with the Wells Branch Parkway Phase IV, Immanuel Road, and East Pflugerville Parkway (Jesse Bohls Road) Corridor Plans as described in the applications for the 2028 – 2031 CAMPO Call for Projects and is willing to commit to working with Travis County on the Corridor Plans development, financing, management, approval, and implementation of the completed planning documents, should the Corridor Plans be selected for funding.
