**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PFLUGERVILLE, TEXAS,  
ADOPTING THE SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE FISCAL  
YEAR 2026 BUDGET FOR THE CITY; AND PROVIDING AN  
EFFECTIVE DATE**

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 1682-25-09-09, an Ordinance of the City of Pflugerville, Texas (“City”), adopting the City’s Fiscal Year 2025-2026 (“FY26”) Budget, was approved by the City Council on September 9, 2025; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 9.04 of the City Charter requires the City Council to adopt an Ordinance if it seeks to amend the FY26 Budget; and,

**WHEREAS**, City Council now seeks to amend the FY26 Budget and to provide for the filing of the amended FY26 Budget with the City Secretary and the office of the County Clerk of Travis County, Texas;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PFLUGERVILLE, TEXAS:**

**Section 1.** The FY26 Budget is amended as shown on **Exhibit A**, as attached.

**Section 2.** The City Secretary shall maintain this amendment to the FY26 Budget in the office of the City Secretary. The City Manager shall provide for the filing of a true copy of this amendment in the office of the County Clerk of Travis County.

**Section 3.** This Ordinance is effective immediately upon its adoption by City Council.

**Section 4.** If any provision of this Ordinance is illegal, invalid, or unenforceable under present or future laws, the remainder of this Ordinance will not be affected and, in lieu of each illegal, invalid, or unenforceable provision, a provision as similar in terms to the illegal, invalid, or unenforceable provision as is possible and is legal, valid, and enforceable will be added to this Ordinance.
