On September 1, 2015, I came across what I considered a public emergency safety issue concerning two street names that were very similar. The two names are **PINON Pine** in Park Place at Heatherwilde (est 2001) and **PINYON Pine** in Falcon Pointe (est 2015).

I immediately recognized the similarities in the street names when I saw the new street in Falcon Pointe established on the 9-1-1 database map. I knew this could be a potential problem with emergency services working under pressure to get officers, fire trucks and/or ambulances to the correct location in an emergency to save someone's life with pronunciation issues if no one knew to question the difference! These two street names are TOO SIMILAR and too close for comfort in these situations when emergencies exist and emergency service personnel are responsible for getting to the correct location.

Understandably, renaming a street causes hardship on someone's end, and causes confusion to residents who may already live there. In the long run, lives of the citizens have to be considered so that there is little to no room for error. And we can all say we have done our part to correct that from Emergency Services all the way to Development Services, I believe that is our duty!
