Regular Meeting

1. Call to Order

Shane Mize, Park Director, presented the commission the directors update. He provided the commission information regarding a Summer recap and project and event updates such as public art, Trail Capital of Texas updates, branded t-shirts, goatscaping, cardboard regatta, and welcoming a new Events Coordinator, Allison Romo.

Jonathan Hanson, Recreation Superintendent, presented to the commission updates regarding Summer Pfun Camp, Aquatics Programs, Programs and Events, Volunteer Cleanups, and Recreation Center Programming.

Shane Mize, Parks Director, presented to the commission information regarding the 2025 Deutschen Pfest Event. He provided information regarding the schedule, tentative event map, changing the name of the kids zone to Wunderpark.

Jonathan Hanson, Recreation Superintendent, went over the carnival rides, vendor layout, vendor highlight/recruitment, food vendor layout, Biergarten, and Mainstage with Friday and Saturday Headliners. He also went over the Pfun Run, the event vision, community vendors, shuttles, tickets, and 2025 sponsorship opportunities.

USA, the new Pforestry website, and the Public Tree Protection Code Update.

Dave Madden, Urban Forester, presented to the commission information regarding Tree Code updates. He provided information regarding the code update, the history (last updated in 2012, went over what is changing, and the purpose and intent of the code. He also went over the Tree Care Advisory Committee and its current duties and recommended duties, Care of Public Trees, Prohibition Against Harm, and the Public Tree Fund.

Commissioner Bridges made a motion to approve the changes to the Tree Code. Commissioner Taylor seconded the motion. All voted in favor and the motion passed.
