**Re: State Fiscal Year 2022 Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF)  
Application Invitation**

Dear Ms. Giannini:

We are pleased to provide you this official notice that the City of Pflugerville is hereby invited to submit an application for funding to the Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) through the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund

The proposed project is listed in the Intended Use Plan (IUP) as being eligible to receive funding as shown below:

Project Description	Water Treatment Plant Expansion Design
Eligible Phases	Construction
Project Information Form Number	14017
Eligible Project Cost	\$24,000,000

The eligible amount is subject to the current maximum commitment amount a project may receive under the SFY 2022 IUP of \$24 million.

For state fiscal year 2022, \$75,000 per project is available as principal forgiveness for the preparation of an emergency preparedness evaluation/audit plan that determines future needs to ensure compliance with statutory and regulatory standards of emergency operations that directly affect operation of a water system during an extended power outage caused by severe weather that impacts the system. You are encouraged to include funds for these activities in your application if interested, even if they were not reflected in the project costs at the time the PIF was submitted.

Both of the following deadlines must be met for the project to receive funding consideration:

- The attached Intent to Apply Form must be submitted via email to [SRFIUPSubmissions@twdb.texas.gov](mailto:SRFIUPSubmissions@twdb.texas.gov) by 5:00pm CST on October 11, 2021. This will allow the TWDB to invite in rank order additional projects on the lists if an invited entity does not wish to pursue SRF funding for their project at this time.
- If you do intend to apply, the complete application must be received by TWDB no later than 5:00 p.m., CST on November 12, 2021. Late submittals will not be accepted. Application submittal guidance and the related application materials may be found on our website at [www.twdb.texas.gov/financial/applications/](http://www.twdb.texas.gov/financial/applications/).

A pre-application conference is a requirement of the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund program.
