Pursuant to Texas Government Code Sec. 551.0415. a member of the governing body may make an announcement about items of community interest during a meeting of the governing body without having given notice of the subject of the announcement. "Items of community interest" includes:

(1) expressions of thanks, congratulations, or condolence;

(2) information regarding holiday schedules;

(3) an honorary or salutary recognition of a public official, public employee, or other citizen, except that a discussion regarding a change in the status of a person's public office or public employment is not an honorary or salutary recognition for purposes of this subdivision;
(4) a reminder about an upcoming event organized or sponsored by the governing body;
(5) information regarding a social, ceremonial, or community event organized or sponsored by an entity other than the governing body that was attended or is scheduled to be attended by a member of the governing body or an official or employee of the political subdivision; and
(6) announcements involving an imminent threat to the public health and safety of people in the political subdivision that has arisen after the posting of the agenda.

4. Public Comment

In accordance with the Texas Attorney General's Opinion, any public comment that is made on an item that is not on the published final agenda will only be heard by the City Council. No formal action, discussion, deliberation, or comment will be made by the City Council. Each person providing public comment will be limited to 3 minutes.

ORD-0690 Approving an ordinance on second reading with a caption reading: An Ordinance of the City of Pflugerville, Texas, Amending Ordinance No. 1478-20-02-09 of the City of Pflugerville, Texas, as amended, by amending the Hill Country Bible Church Planned Unit District (PUD) District approved in ORD 1479-21-02-09, by adding a use within the non-residential districts to allow the use of veterinary clinic for an approximately 48.126 acres of land, out of the T.J. Chambers Survey, Abstract No. 7, the John Vanwinkle Survey, Abstract No. 786, and the Elnathan Bebee Survey, Abstract 53, all in Travis County, Texas to continue to be known as the Hill Country Bible Church Planned Unit District Development (PUD) District (2022-4-PUD); providing for a repeal of conflicting ordinances; providing for severability; and providing for an effective date.
