ORD-0342 Approving an ordinance on first reading with the caption: AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PFLUGERVILLE, TEXAS, ANNEXING, FOR FULL PURPOSES, FIVE TRACTS OF LAND TOTALING 170.63 ACRES SITUATED IN THE E. KIRKLAND SURVEY NO. 7, ABSTRACT NO. 458, OF THE REAL PROPERTY RECORDS OF TRAVIS COUNTY; GENERALLY LOCATED ALONG E. PFLUGERVILLE PARKWAY SOUTH OF LAKE PFLUGERVILLE, EAST OF N.
