

Competitive Sealed Proposals

- Revised timeline for substantial completion in June 2025 omits the need for CMAR.
- Competitive Sealed Proposals will provide the City with the "best value"
- Allows for negotiation of both scope or time modification and price change associated with the modification after proposals are submitted





Secondary Colorado River Raw Water Line Packages

- Increase capacity of the Colorado River Raw Water System from 11 Million Gallon per Day (MGD) to 22 MGD
- Addresses rapid growth in the City
- Four Bid Packages are planned for the project:
 - 1. Pre-purchase of long lead items
 - 2. Pump Station Improvements
 - 3. South section of the water line
 - 4. North section of the water line





Project Update

Completed

- 60% Design (Bid Packages 2, 3 and 4)
- 90% Design (Bid Packages 1)

In-Progress

- 90% Design (Bid Packages 2, 3 and 4)
- 100% Design (Bid Package 1)
- Water Infrastructure
 Finance and Innovation
 Act (WIFIA) Application

Upcoming

- Bid Package 1 advertise
 October 2022
- Bid Package 2, 3 and 4 design completion January 2023
- Easement acquisition to begin in September 2022
