General Assembly Representation Summary for City of Pflugerville

Local representatives from the Capital Area Council of Governments' ten-county region create the General Assembly of the Council.

CAPCOG's bylaws state full members — counties and municipalities — are entitled to appoint at least one representative on the Council's General Assembly. As a full member's population increases, so does its General Assembly representation. The following schedule dictates a full member's potential number of representatives on the General Assembly:

Counties	Municipalities	No. of Representatives
Under 20,000	Under 10,000	1
20,000-100,000	10,000-50,000	2
100,000+	50,000-100,000	3
	100,000+	4

Associate members organizations can have one representative on the General Assembly, according to the Council's bylaws. An associate member organization includes special districts, school districts, nonprofits, utilities, chambers of commerce, and other governmental agencies.

Sustaining members, any person or organization with a positive interest in the welfare of the region, can have a non-voting representative on the General Assembly.

However, the voting representatives of the General Assembly must comprise of at least two-thirds elected officials.

City of Pflugerville qualifies for 3 position(s) on the CAPCOG General Assembly based on State Data Center's most recent population estimates. Its current General Assembly representatives are:
