Pflugerville Colored Addition Cemetery Brief History

The cemetery was established in the 1920s for African-Americans who lived in an area of town known as the colored addition.

Many of the original families have moved and have not been able to maintain the property.



Problems

1. Black Pflugerville has partnered with other groups to help maintain the cemetery, but it's extremely difficult to consistently maintain this property.
2. Infrastructure in the Colored Addition needs to be improved for parking and for walking in that area.



Solutions

1. Give Black Pflugerville a budget and allow us to manage the property.
2. The City of Pflugerville takes over and maintains the Colored Cemetery.
