Worksession

1. Call to order

Mayor Victor Gonzales called the worksession to order at 6:04 p.m. Councilmembers Jeff Marsh, Omar Peña and Mike Heath were in attendance. Councilmember Doug Weiss entered at 6:22 p.m. Councilmember Starlet Sattler was absent. - 2A. [2017-5778](#) Discuss animal shelter update. (Requested by: Mayor Pro Tem Omar Peña)

Ms. Teri Dail, Friends of the Animal Shelter presented a report on their activities and a video advertising a one-day free cat adoption event. Ms. McLendon provided a report and answered questions of Council. Ms. Gillam provided input.

- 2B. [2017-5918](#) Discuss a curfew ordinance. (Requested by Mayor Pro Tem Omar Peña)

Mr. Wade introduced the item. Chief Robledo provided information on the draft ordinance and answered questions of Council. Mr. Hyde provided information. There was continued Council discussion with Chief Robledo.

- 2C. [2017-5919](#) Discuss a distracted driving ordinance. (Requested by Mayor Pro Tem Omar Peña)

Mr. Wade provided an introduction. Mr. Hyde briefed the Council regarding actions of Legislature concerning texting while operating an automobile. He explained that it has been added to the agenda for the special Legislative session to consider expanding to pre-empt local laws. He stated that they might want to wait until the Legislature has completed its special session. Council was in agreement to wait to consider the ordinance.

- 2D. [2017-5921](#) Discuss the Police Department Budget. (Requested by Mayor Pro Tem Omar Peña)

Mr. Wade provided information, stating that the budget is currently being developed and would be provided to the Council prior to July 1, 2017. He noted that the Finance and Budget Committee just completed review of the FY 15, 16, and 17 Police budgets. Mayor Pro Tem Peña asked about the CAD RMS system. Chief Robledo stated that staff has seen a presentation by Spillman and they were impressed. Discussion followed regarding the current collection of data. Mayor Pro Tem Peña asked when they might see the new data going forward. Chief Robledo and Mr. Wade explained that January 2018 would be the start of gathering the new data. Discussion continued. Mr. Marsh provided information on the Finance and Budget Committee's review. He stated that the City is operating on a very lean budget. Mr. Wade stated that the Finance and Budget Committee has not yet seen the FY 18 budget and the Council would receive it first.
