The City of Pflugerville (City) received sealed bid proposals for the Central WWTP Interim Improvements project on January 25th, 2018 at 2:00 pm. Attached is the tabulation of the bids received. All bid proposals were properly executed and submitted in compliance with the bidding requirements for this project. The bid tabulation is attached.

The bidder providing the lowest overall construction cost for the Central WWTP Interim Improvements project is Central Road Utility, Ltd. (CRU). CRU submitted all information required by the Contract Documents including the bid form, bid security and statement of qualifications. Additionally, Freese and Nichols contacted four references for past projects and the references provided positive feedback on CRU's past performance. Based on the bid results as well as CRU's qualifications and past performance, Freese and Nichols (FNI) recommends that CRU be awarded the construction contract for this project. CRU's total bid for the Central WWTP Interim Improvements project is \$832,142.30 (Eight Hundred Thirty-Two Thousand, One Hundred Forty-Two Dollars and Thirty Cents).

Failure to submit the required information in the statement of qualifications may result in the Owner considering the Bid non-responsive and result in rejection of the Bid by the Owner. Bidders may be required to provide supplemental information if requested by the Owner to clarify, enhance or supplement the information provided in the statement of qualifications.
- 1.02 Bidders must provide the information requested in the Qualifications Statement using the forms attached to this Section. A copy of these forms may be provided in Microsoft Word to assist with the preparation of the Statement of Qualifications. Information in these forms must be provided completely and in detail. Information that cannot be totally incorporated in the form may be included in an appendix to the form. This appendix must be clearly referenced by appendix number in the form, and the appended material must include the appendix number on every sheet of the appendix. The appendix must include only the information that responds to the question or item number to which the appended information applies.
- 1.03 Bidders may provide supplemental information to the Statement of Qualifications using AIA, AGC or other industry standard statement of qualification forms and / or Bidders may submit additional information such as organizational brochures or other marketing information to help demonstrate the ability to provide best value to the Owner. This information may not be submitted as a substitute to the information specifically requested in this Section, or in the Statement of Qualifications forms. If this information is include as an appendix to the information requested in Paragraph [1.02] above, the reference must include the specific paragraph or section that applies to that question or item.



In reference to our litigation issue, we are in a lawsuit concerning the use of a geosynthetic liner in a detention pond. CRU, Ltd. constructed the project per the plans and specifications and received an acceptance letter from Geo-Solutions for the correct installation of the pond liner. After installation, and prior to final acceptance the pond liner floated. The pond liner floated due to ground water rising and forcing air up, causing the line to raise above the finished pool elevation. CRU, Ltd. maintains that it is a design issue, however the owner and Engineer believe it is a contractor issue.
