NOW THEREFORE, I, Victor Gonzales, Mayor of the City of Pflugerville, Texas, do hereby proclaim April 30 to May 4, 2018 as Air Quality Awareness Week and encourage our residents and employees to educate themselves about air quality and to promote air quality and air quality awareness within the community.
